JACK BYRD

JACK BYRD, PEARL River head women's soccer coach and co-coordinator of the Wildcat Academy Soccer Camp will enter his third season at the helm of PRCC's women's program this fall. He served as assistant coach under then-head coach and 2010 camp instructor Josh Hess in 2007, but resigned to accept a position with the PRCC Alumni Foundation during the 2008-2009 school year. After Hess re-signed in the spring of 2009, Byrd pursued the head soccer position and was the unanimous choice for the job. In his first season, he guided the Lady Wildcat squad to their second-ever MACJC state championship and was named the MACJC's *Women's Coach of the Year*. Byrd is a 1999 Picayune High School graduate where he was a standout athlete as a three-year letterman on the Maroon Tide soccer team and place kicker on the football squad. His football talents earned him a scholarship to PRCC where he kicked and punted for the Wildcats

AFTER PLAYING for professional soccer programs in England from the age of eight, Dave Stanbra has always been involved with, played and loved soccer. He played for Aston Villa F.C. (EPL) for 3 years, Swindon Town F.C.

for 5 years, Cheltenham Town F.C. and Kidderminster Harriers F.C. Dave saw the opportunity of playing college soccer in the United States as too good of an opportunity to pass up and at the age of 19 signed for The University of South Carolina Upstate. Captaining the side in his senior year Stanbra played four years for the Spartans as a forward and Midfielder. Whilst playing at college Dave was coaching club soccer locally at CFC, coaching boys and girls from the age of 5-18. Being top goal scorer and top point scorer his senior year Stanbra finished his college career and continued to coach such was his love for the game. Back in club soccer Dave coached his first two

in 1999 and 2000. Ouachita Baptist University signed Byrd following his PRCC stint and he lettered both seasons with the Tigers. It was his tenure at OBU that brought him back to his first love — soccer — as he served as athletic director for the Booneville (Ark.) Boys & Girls Club in 2004 and 2005 and as commissioner of the South Logan County Soccer Clubs, while coaching 17-year-old and 19-year-old select programs. Byrd graduated from OBU in 2004 with a bachelor of arts degree in political science with minors in sociology and physical education. At Picayune High, Byrd was named first-team All-State for the 1998 season and played in the 1999 Bernard Blackwell All-Star Classic. From there, he headed to PRCC. Byrd's father, Richard, is an automobile mechanics instructor at Pearl River.

teams and brought instant success winning two league titles and the Carolina State Cup in 2009. After three years of club coaching and High School coaching at Spartanburg High School, Dave took the his position at Pearl River Community College and joined head women's coach Jack Byrd as a Wildcat. Dave Stanbra joined the Wildcats as head men's soccer coach in the fall of 2010. Not knowing any players himself and inheriting a recruiting class from Byrd, Dave took the team on and the responsibilities that came with it. The Wildcats had an outstanding fall 2010 season finishing with an overall record of 12-4-1 reaching the playoffs for the first time in seven seasons. NICK COMES TO US WITH RICH SOCCER past and a wealth of knowledge. Born and raised just outside of London in Towcester, England, Nick grew up with one thing on his mind...Soccer. Nick's passion for the game was evident from an early age and his talent became apparent playing for his local side Towcester Juniors. Professional EPL team Watford F.C. noticed this talent and at the age of 10 Nick was signed up to play with one of the best youth training systems in England. With six years of top class coaching Nick was developing into a fine soccer player



and was becoming better every year. A goal scoring left-back and a free-kick specialist Nick soon became known as Nick 'BECKSTON' by some of his team mates. Nick played with and trained with professional players whilst continually growing as a player. Nick continued to shine and took his talents 'across the pond' to The University of South Carolina Upstate. Nick played four years of NCAA Division I soccer as a starting central defender scoring goals and captaining the side along the way. With NCAA National Tournament playing experience under his belt Nick began coaching at the age of 21 in Club soccer at CFC (Carolina Futbol Club). As his passion for the game remained, his obvious class and knowledge as a coach landed him the Varsity Boys' Head Coaches job at Landrum High School SC. Nick led the Cardinals to their first ever play-off appearance and his outstanding job earned him the accolade as High School

Iain has the gift of great pace and started to become more noticeable as a player with great potential when he played for his local side Badsey Rangers Colts. A flying left winger, his natural grace and eye for goal made professional teams take notice and Iain was soon drafted into the youth side of professional set-up Cheltenham Town F.C. at the age of 15. Iain had a very quick rise to the lofty heights of professional soccer in England and was drafted into first team senior soccer aged just 16. Such was his impression on the head coach he was earmarked as a future star. Playing for the youth and reserve team Iain saw many successes and great times at Cheltenham in his four years before turning his head to other things. The opportunity of college soccer became a reality for Iain in the spring of 2005 after a short visit to the States. NCAA Division II soccer was to be his next stop and a very successful spell with Slippery Rock University followed. Winning the

conference two years of the four and reaching the NCAA National Tournament three years out of four is a tremendous achievement and Iain played a big part in this. He was part of the most successful team in the schools history and made two successful Sweet 16 appearances. Iain has valuable experience as a player and has transformed that into becoming a very accomplished and well polished coach. Coaching club and school, running summer camps has come natural to Iain and his natural ability to demonstrate and initiate practice sessions will be invaluable to any player looking to improve their skills.
